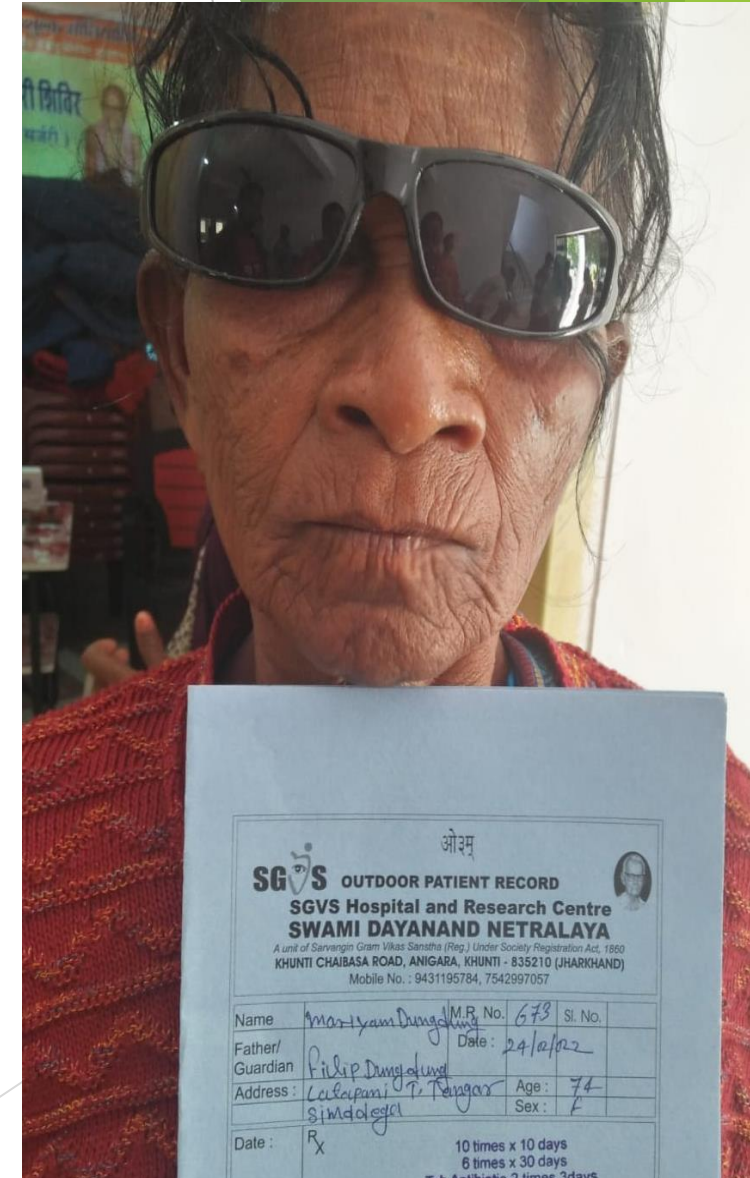

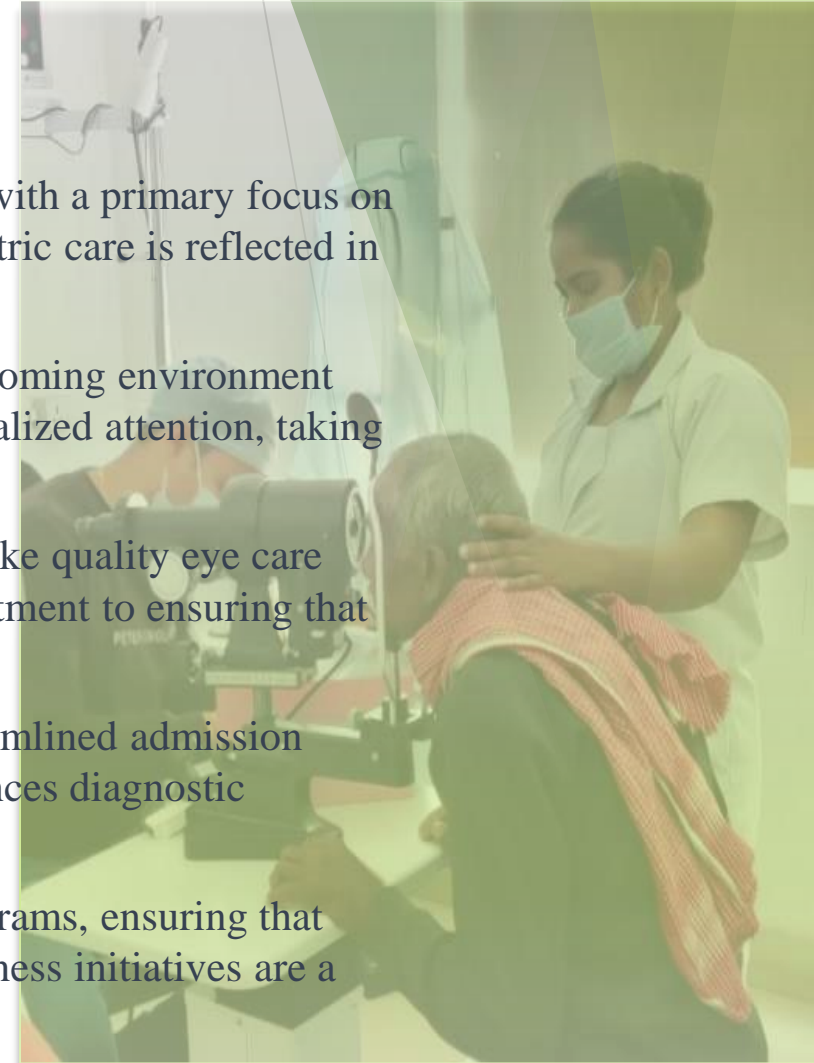

The hospital conducted a total of approx. 1602 eye surgeries, addressing a spectrum of conditions, including cataracts, glaucoma, and refractive disorders. Out of these, 658 surgeries were performed as part of outreach programs, extending specialized eye care to rural communities. Additionally, our eye clinics reached 12,480 individuals through screenings and awareness campaigns. These statistical achievements underscore our commitment to advancing eye health and promoting accessibility to quality treatment for the underserved populations in the region.

खूंटी। घोर नक्सल प्रभावित अड़को थाना क्षेत्र के मारंगबुरु गांव की चार वर्षीय बच्ची बंधनी मुंडा एक बार फिर अपनी दोनों आंखों से दे पा रही है। इसकी खुशी उसके चेहरे पर साफ झलकती है। और यह संभव हुआ है खूंटी के अनिगड़ा स्थित एसजीवीएस नेत्र अस्पताल और हैदराबाद के प्रख्यात नेत्र रोग विशेषज्ञ डॉ कार्तिक जे कार्तिक और उनके तीन सहायक डॉक्टरों के प्रयास से। जानकारी के अनुसार मारंगबुरु गांव के गरीब किसान तुरी मुंडा की चार वर्षीय बेटी की आंखों में मोतियाबिंद हो गई थी। इसके कारण वह देख नहीं पा रही थी। अस्पताल की डाटा बताया कि एसजीवीएस



अस्पताल की टीम मारंगबुरु गांव गई थी। वही उक्त बच्ची के मोतियाबिंद की जानकारी मिली। अस्पताल के कर्मचारियों ने बच्ची के पिता तुरी मुंडा से मुलाकात की और उन्हें बच्ची को अस्पताल लेकर आने को कहा। तुरी ने

किसान तुरी मुंडा ने बताया कि दशहरा के दौरान उसके बेटे ने अपनी बहन बंधनी की आंख में पिटवरी से मार दिया था। इसके कारण उसकी आंखों में लालिमा आ गई और धीरे-धीरे मोतियाबिंद हो गया। डॉ कार्तिक जे कार्तिक ने बताया कि चोट लगने से होने के कारण मोतियाबिंद कठिक्ल था। चार वर्षीय बच्ची के शल्य चिकित्सा के लिए प्राइवेट अस्पतालों 40 हजार से एक लाख रुपये तक का खर्च आ सकता था, लेकिन अस्पताल प्रबंधन द्वारा निशुल्क उपचार कराकर एक नेक कार्य किया गया है। उन्होंने कहा कि गरीब बच्ची का उपचार करने में उन्हें भी काफी अच्छा लगा। डाटा मैनेजर ने बताया कि पद्मभूषण कड़िया मुख और जिला अधिपति निवारण समिति के अध्यक्ष और खूंटी के उपायुक्त शशि रंजन की प्रेरणा से एसजीवीएस अस्पताल में हर वर्ष हजारों लोगों के मोतियाबिंद का निःशुल्क ऑपरेशन किया जाता है।
